The Design-Nation Summer School is a bespoke intensive four-day immersive learning experience with ample time to develop your creativity and embrace opportunities for creative development beyond your chosen discipline.

This Summer School is a hands-on exploration of a self-selecting range of materials, processes and techniques utilising the University of Lincoln's designer maker and arts workshop facilities and professionally experienced technicians and tutors.

There will be demonstrations and one-to-one support throughout the course, with peer review and critique opportunities too.

## The Summer School Programme

Half day self-selecting workshops and studio experience sessions in areas such as the following:

**Maker Lab workshop:** (jewellery / metal / ceramics / glass)

### Traditional Printmaking Studio:

- Screen-printing
- Collagraph
- Etching
- Cyanotypes

**3D Printing:** Including learning relevant software to create your 3D prints



### Multi-materials workshops:



- Laser cutting
- Use of the multi-materials machinery and hand tools

### Photography studio and workshops:

Object / product studio photography  
Cameras and equipment available to hire from the University



### Sculpture and 3D workshop:

Mould making and casting in a variety of materials from plaster and wax to specialist silicone rubbers and epoxy resins.
